Export

The Export function creates a ZIP file of course content that can be used to create a new course. This option does not contain any user data, and is not FERPA protected. You can select what content to export during the export process. To export from a Blackboard course, follow the following steps.

Select the title of the course you want to export from your course list in Blackboard.

In the Control Panel, click on Packages and Utilities,
